#### **ELIGIBILITY FOR MEMBERSHIP**

(Ref: DAV National Bylaws)

Article 11 — Membership Section 11.1 – Definition

Members are persons who have met the eligibility criteria set out herein and have paid the appropriate dues. There shall be no associate, special or honorary memberships. Members who are under suspension are not considered "members" under these Bylaws.

#### Section 11.2 – Membership Eligibility

Para. 1(a): Any man or woman, wounded, gassed, injured or disabled in the line of duty during time of war as substantiated by official medical records of the armed forces, by notation on discharge certificate or Adjutant General's office record, or by United States Department of Veterans Affairs records, while in the service of either the military or naval forces of the United States of America, and who has not been dishonorably discharged or separated from such service, or who may still be in active service in the armed forces of the United States of America is eligible. Others, who were disabled while serving with any of the armed forces of any nations associated with the United States as allies during any of its war periods, who are American citizens and who are honorably discharged, are also eligible for membership. Those who are eligible also include but are not limited to the following:

- 1. All persons who were prisoners of war.
- 2. All persons awarded the Purple Heart.
- 3. All persons with a disability discharge from military service.
- 4. All persons who are receiving or ever did receive compensation from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs for a disability incurred during time of war.
- 5. All persons with a wartime service-connected disability of ANY degree (including those with a rating of less than 10 percent) officially rated by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs.
- 6. All persons awarded vocational training because of injury or disability.
- 7. All persons retired from military service for disability incurred during time of war.
- 8. All persons drawing the statutory award for arrested or cured tuberculosis of wartime service origin.

**(b):** If there is a question on eligibility, it shall be submitted to the National Adjutant for his or her decision. The decision of the National Adjutant under this article shall be final.

#### **ELIGIBILITY FOR MEMBERSHIP**

(Ref: DAV National Bylaws) (cont.)

#### Section 11.3 – Eligibility; Definition of "Time of War"

**Para. 1**: "During time of war," as used in Article III of the National Constitution, shall include the following periods of service:

Mexican War: April 24, 1846, to May 30, 1848

Civil War: April 15, 1861, to August 20, 1866

Indian Wars: From 1869 to 1898 there were 34 campaigns and military expeditions; disability

because of service in any one is sufficient.

Spanish-American War: April 21, 1898, to April 11, 1899

Philippine Insurrection: April 11, 1899, to July 4, 1902

Boxer Rebellion: June 20, 1900, to May 12, 1901

Cuban Pacification: October 6, 1906 to April 1, 1909

Vera Cruz Expedition: April 21, 1914 to November 26, 1914

Punitive Expedition into Mexico: March 15, 1916 to February 5, 1917

World War I: April 6, 1917 to July 2, 1921

World War II & Korea: September 16, 1940 to January 31, 1955

Vietnam and other engagements: January 31, 1955 to October 14, 1976

Iranian Crisis, Lebanon Crisis, Invasion of Grenada, Invasion of Panama and other engagements: November 4, 1979 to January 31, 1990

**Persian Gulf, Somalia, Haiti, Bosnia, Afghanistan, Iraq or other Crises:** August 2, 1990 until terminated by presidential proclamation or congressional resolution

**Para. 2:** The requirement "during time of war" is also met if it is determined that the applicant's wound, injury or disability was incurred at any time (1) as a direct result of armed conflict, or (2) while engaged in extra-hazardous service under conditions simulating war, or (3) while the United States was engaged in any war. A disability incurred or aggravated during service between September 16, 1940, and December 7, 1941, is included in the term "under conditions simulating war."

# **STATE STANDING RULES**

# As amended May 10, 2023

# Approved to Distribute National Judge Advocate Luc 26,2023

#### Section 1. ADMINISTRATION

- A. The name of this organization shall be "Disabled American Veterans Auxiliary, State Department of Tennessee".
- B. This State Department recognizes the National Organization known as Disabled American Veterans Auxiliary and affirms its allegiance and subordination to the National Organization, its Constitution, Bylaws, and all rules, mandates and regulations promulgated pursuant thereto. Upon dissolution of the State Department, the assets remaining after the payment of its debts shall be distributed as provided in Article XI, Section 3 of the National Bylaws.
- C. The State Standing Rules supplement and clarify the Standard State Department Bylaws and may not contradict them.

These State Standing Rules may be amended by a majority vote of the delegates registered and voting at the State Convention. Proposed changes must be submitted to the State Adjutant, typewritten or printed, and signed by the sponsor or sponsoring unit, no later than the close of the pre-convention State Executive Board meeting.

- D. A member, while holding membership simultaneously in the Auxiliary and the parent organization, shall not have the right to hold an office in the Auxiliary, make or speak on a motion, or vote while holding an office (elective or appointive) and/or chairmanship in the Disabled American Veterans.
- E. There will be no Districts, Regions or Zones in the State Department of Tennessee, but in-as-much as possible, the three Grand Divisions of Tennessee will be observed in elections and appointments.
- F. The wearing of jewelry shall be as set forth in the Standard State Department Bylaws. State Officers, State Chairmen and Past State Commanders shall be entitled to wear the white cap of the State Department of Tennessee, Disabled American Veterans Auxiliary. Any member of a local Unit shall be entitled to wear the blue cap of the Disabled American Veterans Auxiliary.

#### Section 2. FISCAL RESPONSIBILTY

- A. State Department fiscal year will begin July 1 and end the following June 30.
- B. The State Department per capita for Life Members shall be as stated in the National Constitution and Bylaws. There shall be no per capita for Junior members.
- C. Each Auxiliary Unit shall pay to the State Department Headquarters (State Adjutant) office, the sum of \$50.00 per year, not later than sixty (60) days following the close of the State Convention. All money will be deposited into the general fund and used for State Department administrative expenses.

#### D. Disbursements:

- The State Department shall use check requests (vouchers) which shall be initiated by and signed by the State Adjutant and co-signed by the State Commander. The alternate signature shall be the State Senior Vice Commander.
- Cash withdrawals of Auxiliary funds are NOT allowed.
- 3. Expenses of those attending Conventions, Conferences and Meetings shall be as set forth in the State Department Budget. In order to receive reimbursement, the designated member must attend all meetings unless serving on an Auxiliary committee or excused by the Commander. Appropriate receipts must be submitted for all expenses.
- E. In order to avoid the appearance of impropriety, the bank account signees (Commander, Senior Vice Commander and Treasurer) may not be from the same family.
- F. The State Department may audit a Unit's records at the direction of the State Commander.

#### Section 3. GOVERNING POWER

The governing power shall be the State Convention and State Executive Committee between conventions.

The State Convention and Mid-Winter Conference shall be held at the time and place selected by the Disabled American Veterans Department of Tennessee.

The State Commander and State Adjutant shall have the power to provide the call for the annual State Convention and the Mid-Winter Conference and to provide the form of credentials for same. Also, to rule on all matters pertaining to both, if not specifically covered by the State Standing Rules or the Convention rules.

A member shall not hold more than one state office, elective or appointive, with the exception of the office of Adjutant and Treasurer. This restriction does not apply to positions of committee chairmen, or to State Executive Committee Members. Any elected state officers who are entitled to vote on the State Executive Committee shall not serve as a unit's State Executive Committee Member.

#### A. State Executive Committee

The purpose of the State Executive Committee is to approve all appointments and to conduct business between State Conventions. This may be done by in-person or virtual meetings of the State Executive Committee or by written ballots. A majority of the votes during a meeting or written ballots received by the State Adjutant by the designated date shall constitute the decision of the committee. One third (1/3) of all eligible voting members of the State Executive Committee shall constitute a quorum during in-person or virtual meetings.

The State Executive Committee shall be composed of the State Commander, who shall be the presiding officer, the State Senior Vice Commander, the State Junior Vice Commanders, the State Treasurer, the Immediate Past State Commander, any active resident Past National Commander and one State Executive Committee Member or Alternate elected by each Unit.

State Executive Committee Members and Alternates shall be installed at the same time as the State Department Officers or, if absent, as soon as possible thereafter, by a proper installing officer as set forth in the State Department Standard Bylaws.

One State Executive Committee meeting shall be held within twenty-four (24) hours preceding each State Convention and Mid-Winter Conference and one State Executive Committee meeting shall be held within twenty-four (24) hours following the adjournment of each State Convention. Additional meetings may be called, with sufficient notice, by the State Commander or upon written request by seven (7) members of the State Executive Committee.

#### **B. State Convention**

The purpose of the State Convention is to:

- Consider changes to the State Standing Rules
- 2. Review Financial Records of the State Department
- 3. Creation of a State Budget
- 4. Approval of State Officers reports
- 5. Approval of State Committee reports
- 6. Election of State Officers, Nominating and Finance committee members
- 7. Election of State Delegate and Alternate to National Convention
- 8. Transact any other business of the State Department

### **Composition of the Convention:**

The State Convention shall be composed of the elected State officers, the Past State Commanders, any active resident Past National Commander, and the elected delegates representing chartered Units within the state. In order to vote, the delegate or alternate must be in attendance in-person, properly registered, not indebted to the organization and their current membership dues received by National Headquarters Elected State Officers, Past State Commanders and active resident Past National Commanders shall be entitled to one vote at the State Convention.

- 1. Each unit shall be entitled to one (1) elected delegate and one (1) elected alternate for its charter, and one delegate and one alternate for each ten (10) life members or major fraction thereof whose membership dues have been received by National Headquarters at the time of the call to convention.
- 2. Juniors shall not have the privilege of voting at a Unit meeting or at a State Convention.

The State Credentials Committee, consisting of the appointed Chairman, the State Adjutant and the State Assistant Adjutant, must establish a quorum and determine voting privilege for the State Convention. The State Credential Chairman shall make a preliminary report at the first business session of the Convention. Thereafter, the State Credentials Chairman shall make supplementary reports. The final report shall be given immediately prior to the nomination and election of State Officers.

#### **Duties of the Convention:**

The State Convention shall approve the reports of all state constituted committees. The Program committees judge annual reports for award purposes and Standing committees which review the business practices of the State Department.

The State Convention shall elect a Nominating Committee during the first business session of the state convention. The State Nominating Committee shall consist of three members, one from each Grand Division of Tennessee. The Immediate Past State

Commander shall be the Advisor to the State Nominating Committee. All candidates for office shall appear before the State Nominating Committee at the time and place selected by the Committee. The Nominating Committee shall consider, and present to the State Convention, a slate of candidates it has nominated for office.

The State Convention shall elect a State Finance Committee during the last business session of the state convention. The State Finance Committee shall be composed of three committee members, one from each Grand Division of Tennessee, who are elected for a three-year term. Vacancies for the remainder of the current year shall be filled with an appointment made by the State Commander and approved by the State Executive Committee. The State Convention shall elect a replacement member to complete the remainder of that three-year term due to vacancies.

Election of state officers shall occur during the last business session of the convention. The State Convention shall elect a State Commander, a State Senior Vice Commander, State First and Second Junior Vice Commanders, a State Treasurer, and a State Judge Advocate. The State Commander and the State Vice Commanders shall be alternated among the three Grand Divisions of Tennessee, whenever possible, although Grand Division criteria does not limit nominations from the floor for any office. All nominations and elections shall be conducted in accordance with the State Standing Rules and Convention Rules. The state officers shall be installed immediately following the close of the State Convention and shall serve until a successor has been elected and installed.

The State Convention shall elect the delegate and alternate to the National Convention after the election of state officers in the final business session. The delegate to the National Convention from the State Department of Tennessee shall be the State Commander. The State Senior Vice Commander shall be the alternate for the National Convention. If neither the Commander nor Senior Vice Commander will be able to attend National Convention, the privilege of delegate/alternate shall devolve in order of succession. If no State Officer can attend National Convention, the delegate/alternate shall be elected from the convention body.

#### Section 4. DUTIES OF STATE OFFICERS

Elected State Officers shall submit a report at the State Convention of their activities for the year.

#### A. State Commander:

- 1. State Commanders shall not succeed themselves unless completing an unexpired term of fewer than nine (9) months.
- The State Commander shall appoint the following officers: State Adjutant, State
  Assistant Adjutant, State Chaplain, and State Sergeant-at-Arms. The State
  Commander may appoint the following: State Assistant Sergeant-at-Arms, State
  Color Bearer, State Banner Bearer, and State Musician.
- 3. The State Commander shall appoint the following program Chairmen: Americanism, Junior Activities, Mae Holmes Outstanding Unit, and VAVS. NOTE: The <u>State Senior Vice Commander</u> shall be the Membership Chairman and shall conduct at least one membership drive within the year. The <u>State First Junior Vice Commander</u> shall be the Community Service Chairman and the <u>State Second Junior Vice Commander</u> shall be the Legislative Chairman.

- 4. The State Commander shall appoint the following **convention** Chairmen: State Convention, Credentials, and Awards.
- 5. The State Commander shall appoint the following State Standing Committees: State Standing Rules and Audit.
- 6. The State Commander may appoint any other Chairmanships or committees deemed necessary.
- The State Commander shall be responsible for submitting recommendations for the position of VAVS Representative in the various VA facilities to National Headquarters.
- 8. The State Commander shall be responsible for having the Flag and Auxiliary banner at all meetings, if needed.
- 9. The State Commander shall be responsible for presenting the State Department's gift to the National Representative. Reimbursement will be paid (up to the amount specified in the budget) upon submission of voucher and receipt(s).
- 10. The State Commander shall be responsible for the presenting Tennessee's report of state activities and assigned program reports/training at the 8<sup>th</sup> District meeting.

#### B. State Treasurer:

In addition to the duties in the Standard State Bylaws, the State Treasurer shall:

- 1. Provide the State Finance Committee Chairman with a breakdown of the current year's income and expenditures for the committee's budget planning meeting.
- 2. Set the time and place for the Audit Committee to meet after July 1st and before September 20th.
- Provide all Financial Records (e.g., bank statements, vouchers, receipts, State budget, Finance Committee and/or State Executive Committee minutes relating to expenditures, etc.)
- Complete the Financial Report Form furnished by National Headquarters and provide to the Audit Committee along with a copy of the 990-N e-postcard acknowledgement.

## C. State Adjutant:

In addition to the duties in the Standard State Bylaws, the State Adjutant shall:

- Be responsible for ensuring that copies of Convention Rules are distributed to the convention delegates prior to the first business session and copies of Proposed Changes to the State Standing Rules and Proposed Budget are distributed prior to discussion of same.
- 2. Mail one (1) copy of the 'approved for distribution' version of State Standing Rules to each Unit after the changes have been approved by the National Judge Advocate.
- Send written request to DAV Department to hold all fundraising activities approved by the State Executive Committee and/or convention body for the upcoming year, including any subsequent changes.
- 4. Assign appropriate duties to the State Assistant Adjutant.

#### D. State Assistant Adjutant:

At the request of the State Adjutant, the State Assistant Adjutant shall record and transcribe the minutes of the State Convention, State Mid-Winter Conference and the State Executive Committee meetings. The State Assistant Adjutant shall perform other duties as assigned.

## E. State Chaplain:

- 1. The State Chaplain shall assist the Department Chaplain in planning the Memorial Services.
- The State Chaplain may send out appropriate cards/memorials for the State
   Department. Reimbursement will be paid (up to the amount specified in the budget)
   upon submission of voucher and receipt(s).

### F. State Sergeant at Arms:

The State Sergeant at Arms and/or State Assistant Sergeant at Arms shall conduct all visitors to the podium to be recognized and shall conduct all newly elected officers to the proper station to be installed.

#### G. State Color/Banner Bearer

- The State Color Bearer shall see to the proper placement of the American Flag in the meeting room. If there is a presentation of the Colors, the State Color Bearer shall carry the Flag.
- The State Banner Bearer shall see to the proper placement of the Auxiliary banner. If there is a presentation of the Colors, the State Banner Bearer shall carry the State Department banner.

#### H. State Musician:

The State Musician shall lead the National Anthem and render appropriate music upon request of the Commander.

#### Section 5. DUTIES OF STATE CHAIRMEN AND REPRESENTATIVES

# A. State Program Chairmen:

State Chairmen for the Americanism, Community Service, Junior Activities, Legislative, Membership, Mae Holmes Outstanding Unit and VAVS programs shall:

- 1. Work closely with the Unit Chairmen.
- 2. Be responsible for explaining their program at the Mid-Winter Conference. Should a State Chairman be unable to attend, the report is to be mailed to the State Adjutant prior to the Mid-Winter Conference.
- 3. Report to the State Convention body the statewide program activity during the year
- 4. Serve as Advisor (and one of the three committee members) during annual judging of their reports at the state convention. Note: Membership awards are mathematically calculated and do not require a convention committee for judging.
- Present the judging committee's report for annual awards.

## B. State Standing Committee Chairmen:

The Chairmen for the State Standing Committees shall call and conduct the committee meetings and report to the State Convention.

#### C. Other Chairmen:

- 1. The Awards Chairman shall be responsible for obtaining and completing any certificates to be presented at the State Convention.
- 2. The Convention Chairman shall be responsible for:
  - Appointing committee members to assist with any of the related Convention tasks.

- Registration for the Mid-Winter Conference and State Convention (which shall entitle this person to any funds allocated for the Convention Chairmen in the budget).
- c. Registration for the Forget-Me-Not Luncheon
- d. Decorations for the Forget-Me-Not Luncheon, Commander's Reception, and Banquet.
- e. Assist in obtaining items for Convention bags and assembly thereof (usually evening before Convention registration).
- f. Introducing and enhancing awareness of all activities and fundraisers occurring during the convention/conference.
- 3. The Ways and Means Chairman shall be responsible for the fundraising activities for the state. Unless specifically appointed, the Convention Chairman will serve as the Ways and Means Chairman. The Ways and Means Chairman shall be responsible for:
  - a. Obtaining items for fundraisers when appropriate.
  - b. Having the Fundraising Supplies (e.g., tickets, containers, etc. for all drawings) for Mid-Winter Conference and State Convention available.
  - c. Securing the monies from the Fundraisers during the meetings (Mid-Winter and State convention).
  - d. Turning over all proceeds to the Treasurer at the completion of each fundraiser.
  - e. Holding any other fundraiser as approved by the State Department.

# D. VAVS Representatives:

Upon receipt and review of the recommendation by the State Commander, the VAVS Representative is certified by National for up to a two (2) year period and must be recertified when the term expires in order to continue in that capacity. The Representative recommends the Deputies at their facility. At-Large members are not eligible to be VAVS Representatives or Deputies.

VAVS Representatives and Associate Representatives shall:

- Report on the activities in their installation for the past calendar year at the Mid-Winter Conference. Should a VAVS Representative be unable to attend, the report is to be mailed to the State Adjutant prior to the Mid-Winter Conference.
- 2. Keep accurate records showing the source of income and amount, funds deposited (if a bank account is maintained), and expenditures with receipts attached. In the event VAVS Representatives and Associate Representatives maintain a checking account, there shall be one signature required on checks.
- Provide all financial records to the State Finance Committee for audit during the Mid-Winter Conference. These records shall be forwarded annually to the State Department Adjutant for to be retained for 7 years.

#### Section 6. STATE STANDING COMMITTEES

All State committees shall consist of three (3) members unless otherwise specified. No two (2) members from the same unit may serve on any committee with the exception of Convention, Credentials and Fundraising/Ways and Means.

#### A. State Finance Committee:

The State Commander, State Senior Vice Commander and State Treasurer may attend the State Finance Committee meetings; however, they are not committee members and do not have a vote.

The State Finance Committee shall:

- 1. Review and verify all revenue, expenditures and investments of the State Department between State Conventions.
- 2. Prepare a budget which shall be submitted and distributed to the State Convention delegates for adoption.
- 3. Review and verify the records of the DAVA-VAVS Representative(s) and Associate Representative(s) annually.
- 4. Serve for a three-year term. NOTE: All members shall be elected for a three-year term except for the original members. The original members, starting with the year 1991, shall be as follows: One to serve for one year, one to serve for two years and one to serve for three years. Thereafter, one committee member shall be elected for a three (3) year term at each State Convention. For the first year, the one-year member shall serve as Chairman of the Committee; the second year, the two-year member shall be the Chairman and, thereafter, the member with the most seniority on the Committee shall be the Chairman. For the 1991 92 year, the one-year member shall be from the Middle Division, the two-year member shall be from the East Division and the three-year member shall be from the West Division.

## B. State Standing Rules Committee:

Appointed by the State Commander, the State Standing Rules Committee shall consist of three (3) members, one from each Grand Division of Tennessee. The <u>State Judge Advocate</u> shall be one of the committee members and shall serve as Chairman of the committee. The State Standing Rules Committee shall consider all properly prepared resolutions/ amendments/ revisions and present their recommendation(s) to the convention delegates.

#### C. State Audit Committee:

Appointed by the State Commander, the State Audit Committee shall consist of three (3) members, either Past State Commanders or members with accounting experience. Members of the State Finance Committee shall not serve on the State Audit Committee.

The State Audit committee shall:

- Audit the records of the State Treasurer including but not limited to bank statements, vouchers, receipts, State budget, Finance Committee and/or State Executive Committee minutes relating to expenditures, etc.
- Sign the Financial Report Form furnished by National Headquarters.
- 3. Provide the signed Financial Report Form and a copy of the 990-N e-postcard acknowledgement to the State Adjutant no later than September 20th for submission to National Headquarters by September 30th.
- Make a full report of the audit findings to the State Convention delegates for approval.

#### Section 7. STATE ANNUAL AWARDS

The State Department shall participate in the annual judging of reports at State Convention using the National membership categories and program criteria to select the best all-around reports for the Americanism, Special Americanism, Community Service, VAVS, Legislative, Mae Holmes Outstanding Unit, Junior Activities, and Outstanding Junior of the Year programs.

If any membership category has only a single unit, then they will automatically be the winner for that category for submission to National Headquarters. However, for the purpose of the State awards, they will be judged with the next closest membership category.

The State awards shall be certificates for Winner and Honorable Mention (no ties allowed) in each program category unless otherwise stated.

**Membership** awards, given by category, shall be calculated using the formula:

**Recruiter** award is given the person recruiting the most life Auxiliary members in the current year based on the DAV Membership Recruiter Report. Employees of the DAV are not eligible as they have greater contact with prospective members than the average member. This award includes a cash incentive as specified in the budget.

Outstanding Member of the Year award will be given to the State Department's nominee for the Past National Commander's Award and shall be judged according to their criteria.

#### Section 8. RULES OF THE STATE CONVENTION

- A. Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised, shall apply except as hereinafter specifically stated.
- B. For the purpose of recognition, a member at the convention, must (1) Stand or Raise Hand if unable to rise, (2) Address the Chair, (3) State name and Unit, or title for State voting privilege (e.g. Past State Commander), and (4) Proceed to speak only after recognition by the Chair.
- C. Debate shall be limited to two (2) minutes for each speaker, except by two-thirds (2/3) consent.
- D. Only such persons who are members in attendance in-person, in good standing, registered, and fully accredited as Delegates or Alternates acting as Delegates shall participate directly or indirectly in a discussion or vote on any subject of the convention.
- E. Delegates of any Unit which is indebted to National or State Headquarters, in any amount, shall not be seated and cannot vote in the Convention until such indebtedness is cleared.
- F. There shall be no voting by proxy. There shall be no form of Unit Rule. When any delegation is entitled to cast more votes than the number of delegates present, the vote of the absent delegates shall be cast in the same proportion as the vote of the delegates present.
- G. Each Unit shall elect a chairman who shall announce the vote of the delegation. When a poll of a delegation is demanded the chairman shall poll the delegation without debate or discussion.

H. Voting shall be by voice except where a roll call is ordered by the Chairman or demanded by at least three (3) units.

In the election of state officers, voting shall be by: voice vote when there is no contest; or roll call when there are two or more candidates nominated for any one office. Roll call(s) shall continue until completed. The candidate receiving a majority (more than 1/2) of the roll call votes shall be elected.

Procedure for a roll call is as follows:

- 1. Units (in numerical order)
- 2. Past State Commander(s)
- 3. Active resident Past National Commander(s)
- Elected State Officers
- I. In conformity with the State Bylaws, the State Officers shall serve as Officers of the Convention, and the State Adjutant shall serve as Adjutant of the Convention.
- J. Discussion of personal grievances, local conditions, or claims concerning one (1) individual with respect to personal interests, shall not be in order, but may be discussed before a Committee of the convention, as directed by the State Commander.
- K. The Convention Credentials Committee shall consist of a Chairman appointed by the State Commander, the State Adjutant and the State Assistant Adjutant. This committee shall determine the eligibility of all persons seated and voting in the State Convention and shall specifically notify the delegates as to the number of votes to which each delegation shall be entitled. The Chairman shall make a preliminary report at the first business session of the Convention. Thereafter, the Chairman shall make supplemental reports. The final report shall be given prior to the nomination and election of State Officers.
- L. The following committees are hereby set forth as committees of this Convention: Awards, Credentials, Finance, Membership, Nominating and Standing Rules. The following Convention Committees shall consider matters relating to their respective programs: Americanism, Community Service, Junior Activities, VAVS, Legislative, and Mae Holmes Outstanding Unit. These Committees shall consider such matters as are assigned to them or properly brought before them.
- M. Each committee shall consist of three (3) members of which no two (2) members shall be from the same unit. The State Chairman of each committee shall serve as the Chairman and present the report of the committee when called upon by the Chair. The report shall be signed by the members of the committee.
- N. State Officers shall submit a report at the State Convention of their activities for the year.
